detergent such as NETTOYANT MULTIUSAGES, rinsing, drying

PRODUCT APPLICATION

Process Spread the product to saturation with a sponge, cloth or mop, depending on the site's

possibilities

Let it dry (about 30 mins by 20°C) and recoat rapidly with the SUNCOAT varnish at least

within 2 hours after its application

Beyond this time, the action of the PRIMAIRE SUNCOAT is cancelled and requires new

treatment

Dilution Ready-for-use product

Shake before use (VERY IMPORTANT)

* Application conditions:

. Ambient and surface temperature above 5°C (caution if T > 35°C)

. Relative humidity below 90 %

. Dry and condensation-free surface

. Sheltered from wind and direct sunlight

* Respect the recoat time between layers
